Department of Pharmacy Practice Report on Advanced Level Workshop on Pharmacovigilance

Department of Pharmacy Practice organized an 'Advanced Level Workshop on Pharmacovigilance' in association with National Coordination Center - Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI); and Regional Training Center, JSS Medical College & Hospital on 8th& 9th December 2017 at JSS College of Pharmacy, Mysuru. The aim of this workshop was to provide training in order to advance the knowledge and develop skills amongst technical associates and coordinators of Adverse Drug Reaction Reporting & Monitoring Centres (AMCs) of PvPI, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India located in the States of Karnataka, Kerala, Puducherry & Tamil Nadu. The workshop was inaugurated on 8th December 2017 by Dr. B. Manjunatha, Registrar, JSS University, Mysuru. Dr. G. Parthasarathi, Coordinator, Dr. M.
