

In the post lunch session, Rationalizing and Constructing alignment of Course outcomes to Program Outcomes and Program Specific Outcomes were discussed. Quantifying the Program outcomes its Attainment and Analysis was demonstrated using MS-Excel.

The program was well received from the participants, and they opined that more such programs are needed to hand hold the implementation of OBE in their institutions. In the concluding remark, Dean IQAC requested the participants to further disseminate the concept of OBE to all the colleagues at respective institutions and departments and to develop the specific and measurable program & course outcomes for all programs offered.








