- 3. Regulatory agencies and their roles (e.g., FDA in the United States, EMA in Europe, PMDA in Japan).

He explained that the regulatory agencies, along with many others around the world, collaborate and harmonize their regulatory standards to ensure the global availability of safe and effective pharmaceutical products. Pharmaceutical companies must navigate the regulatory landscape and comply with the requirements of multiple agencies to bring their products to market and provide patients with access to high-quality medicines.



Lastly, he explored and informed the audience about many career paths and opportunities available in pharmaceutical regulatory affairs along with the requisite skills and qualifications and job responsibilities for each position.
