

## Industrial Visit Report – 2017

As a part of the curriculum the Department of Pharmaceutical Analysis had organised an industrial visit to Goa for the First and Second M. Pharmacy students of Pharmaceutical Analysis and Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance. A total number of 09 girls and 13 Boys along with 13 boys of Final B. Pharmacy students and 3 accompanying staff participated in the visit. As a part of the industrial visit all the students and staff attended “World Congress on Pharmaceutical Sciences” organised by Conference Era at Goa from 5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> October 2017. The group started the visit on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2017 from the college campus at around 6.00 AM, reached Calicut at 3.00 PM and boarded Netravathi Express to Goa. They reached Goa on 4<sup>th</sup> morning and the accommodation was arranged at Maizon’s Lake View resorts. On the same day they visited Lupin Pharma, Verna Industrial Estate Goa. The visit was coordinated by Dr. Madhu Prakash, Senior Manager – Regulatory Affairs, (Our Alumni). A small presentation on the activities of the Lupin was presented by the training team and the students were taken around the industry to visit the manufacturing unit, warehousing unit and the water treatment plant. After the industrial visit the students visited Baga Beach.

On 5<sup>th</sup> October 2017 the staff and the students participated in the inaugural function of the world congress on pharmaceutical sciences, Inaugurated by Dr. Vadlamudi Rao, President, IPA and other chief guests invited for the function. After the inaugural session they attended various oral and poster sessions organised in the conference.

On 6<sup>th</sup> October 2017 at 9.30 AM the students visited Glenmark Pharma, Hormone manufacturing Unit at South Goa. The visit was coordinated by Mr. Mohan Kumar, Dy Manager, Hormone Block. The students were divided into two groups and they were taken inside to view the ware house for the storage of raw materials, finished products, tablet manufacturing, capsule manufacturing and packaging Processes. The Dy manager interacted with the students and explained the process of manufacturing. After the Glenmark visit in the afternoon session they attended the conference and participated in various oral and poster presentation session and presented their papers. After the conference they went for a boat ride “Goa by Night”.

On 7<sup>th</sup> October 2017, the students attended the conference and presented their papers in the oral and poster presentation sessions. At 2.00 PM they attended the valedictory program and received the presentation certificates. Mr. Kartika Anoop of II M. Pharmacy (Pharmaceutical Analysis), Received the best presentation award with a cash price of Rs. 1000/- for the oral presentation made in the Young researchers forum. After the function they visited Calangute beach and Candolim beach.

On 8<sup>th</sup> October 2017, the students went for sight-seeing to Aguoda fort, Old church, New Church, Vagator Beach, Anjuna Beach and Miramar beach. At 6.00 PM they departed to Magoan Railway station and boarded Madgoan – ER express at 8.30 PM.

On 9<sup>th</sup> October 2017 they reached Calicut railway station at around 8.00 AM and departed to Ooty by bus and reached the college campus safely by 3.00 PM.
