

30th September 2018: On the occasion of Golden jubilee celebrations of NSS, NSS Units of JSS AHER, Mysuru and Clean Mysuru Foundation, Mysuru jointly organized cleanliness program under Swatchh Hi Seva program of Swatchh Bharath initiative of Govt of India, today at Chamundi Hill.

In the first phase of activities, a rally was conducted near the temple creating awareness on cleanliness. About 250 NSS volunteers of 4 units of JSS AHER were involved in the program.

In the second phase, plastic and other wastes were collected at three locations of Chamundi Hill. 1. Near the Temple premises, 2. Nandi Temple area, and 3. View point. About 50 bags of plastic were collected. Parallel to these events, a health monitoring camp was organised where around 200 beneficiaries got their BP and random blood sugar checked.
