JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research Supporting Sustainable Development Goals Through Quality Education, Research & Health Care – A Global Impact

The Times Higher Education Impact Rankings assess universities against the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in global performance tables. The 2023 Impact Rankings is the fifth edition and the overall ranking includes 1519 universities/ HEIs from 115 countries/regions which was released on 1st June, 2023.

JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research was positioned in Rank Band 301 to 400 with 7th Rank in India, participating in 10 SDGs. Being a Health Sciences based Higher Education Institute, it excelled well in **SDG 3** - **Good Health and Wellbeing** scoring 87.4 percentage, positioning at **16**th **rank out of 1218 institutions globally** and **1**st **in India**. This reflects the quality and world class standard in teaching, learning, research, and health care practices in JSS AHER. Securing **65**th **rank for SDG 1**- **No Poverty out of 876 institutions globally** and **1**st **in India**, JSS AHER is once again recognized for its services to the society through outreach activities.
