



Registration and Identification	The candidates should register their names at entrance of the hall by producing the NEET UG 2017 Score & Rank card, Original TAT card & MCC online allotment order.	
Verification of Original Certificates	After completion of Registration and identity confirmation the candidate shall move to the allotted verification counter and produce all the original certificates, for verification by College officials. The original certificates will be retained within the College once the admission is confirmed.	
Admission	The candidate would be advised to complete the other admission procedure, where the certificates and other documents would have been duly forwarded.	
Fee Payment	The candidate would be advised to complete the fee payment process and collection of fee receipt
