INSTITUTIONAL OFFLINE MOP-UP COUNSELLING

(3rd Stray Vacancy Round for BDS seats – 2020)

UG – DENTAL (BDS) ADMISSION - 2020 FOR UNFILLED GENERAL (MGMT) SEATS

(Subject to change based on directions of Court or authorities)

As per the compliance with judgement dated 08.02.2021 in “W.P. (C) No. 54 of 2021 in the matter of Harshit Agarwal & Ors. V/s Union of India & Ors.”, the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India, directed that the vacant seat in 1st year BDS course for the year 2020-21 shall be filled up from the candidates who have participated in the NEET (UG) 2020 courses for the year 2020-21 after lowering the percentile marks by 10 percentile. Based on the qualifying criteria, the reduced cut off percentile shall be 40 for general category, 30 for SC/ST/OBC & 35 for Pwd.

In compliance of the above, the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) had announce the fresh registration/payment process starting from 12.02.2021 to 14.02.2021 (up to 12:00 noon as per server timing) and payment facility will be available till 14.02.2021 (up to 3:00 PM as per server timing). As per directions & Calendar of events announced by MCC of DGHS, regarding conduct of Institutional 3rd Stray Vacancy round counseling for BDS seats 2020-21, The JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research, Mysuru (Deemed to be University), invites your kind attention to the **Institutional 3rd Stray Vacancy round of counseling 2020-21** which is scheduled to be conducted from **15.02.2021 to 18.02.2021** (up to 8:00 PM as per server timing) to fill up the vacant seats subject to availability in UG Dental (BDS) programs and the counseling will be conducted as per the directions of MCC of DGHS.

Eligibility: The MCC registered and unallotted candidates are only eligible for participation for **Institutional 3rd Stray Vacancy round of counseling 2020-21** for the vacant seats followed by counseling and seat allotment which will be done on inter-se merit in NEET UG 2020 All India Rank. Candidate’s name/details should appear under NEET Qualified un-allotted Candidate list to be shared by MCC of DGHS.

Procedure:

- Candidates attending institutional 3rd Stray Vacancy round counseling 2020-21 should satisfy all the eligibility requirement as per the NEET UG Information Brochure – 2020, the minimum eligibility requirements as prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Dental Council of India regulations for admission to UG Dental (BDS) course.
- The seats will be allotted through Institutional 3rd Stray Vacancy counseling based on the inter-se merit in NEET UG 2020 All India Rank, amongst the candidates present on the said date and time. No cancellation will be entertained after this admission.
- The physical presence of the candidate at the counseling is mandatory.**
- The candidates will have to submit their original certificates and also pay the prescribed fee on the dates of counseling mentioned, otherwise the seat allotted get cancelled without any prior notice.
- The Candidates who are not able to comply with the above requirements will be deemed to have forfeited their seats and the same will be made available to the next available candidate on merit basis.
- The candidates will have to satisfy the eligibility requirements for admission to BDS program as prescribed by the competent authority.

IMPORTANT NOTE: There will be active verification of the NEET UG 2020 All India Rank submitted by the candidate with the information available in the MCC website. Such of those candidates whose NEET UG 2020 All India rank does not match with the information in the MCC website will be disqualified from the counseling process.

On the day of Counseling

1. The physical presence of the candidate at the counseling is mandatory.
2. Only the candidate and parent will be allowed into the campus & counseling hall. This is done in view of the COVID situation and the safety of all.
3. Candidate should sign the attendance register to mark their presence.
4. Candidates will be called as per their NEET UG 2020 All India Rank for document verification. Successful candidates will be allotted seats according to their All India NEET UG 2020 rank based on the number of seats available under All India Category. Such candidates should produce their original documents for verification and pay the first-year fees at the time of counseling. **JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research will not entertain any requests for extension regarding fee payment.**
5. The option exercised by you with regard to selection of the course of study at the time of counseling will be final.
6. Absence of the candidate at the indicated reporting time and date will result in the instantaneous forfeiture of any claim for a seat.

After Admission:

1. Admission order/Provisional Admission Order and receipt/s for the payment made will be given to the candidate on completion of the admission process.
2. Candidates should report to the allotted college on or before the reporting date mentioned in the admission order.
3. Candidates who require hostel facility should report to Chief Warden of the allotted campus for hostel enrollment. Hostel will be allotted on payment of hostel fees only.
