## NRI / NRI sponsored category candidates. NEET UG-2020 qualified candidates who were allotted a seat under NRI / NRI

NEET UG-2020 qualified candidates who were allotted a seat under NRI / NRI sponsored category through MCC counseling 2020 for admission to MBBS & BDS courses at JSS Medical College, Mysore and JSS Dental College & Hospital, Mysuru, are required to fulfill all the eligibility criteria of NRI / NRI sponsored category as per directions/orders dated 22-08-2020 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case (W.P. (C) No.689/2017 Consortium of Deemed universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Anr. Vs. Union Of India & Ors.).

**Please Note:** Please refer eligibility conditions for NRI/ NRI Sponsored category, as per the directions / orders of Hon'ble Supreme court of India dated 22-08-2020 in case (W.P.(C) No. 689/2017 – Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Anr. Vs. Union of India & Ors) dated 22-08-2017. Hon'ble Supreme court of India orders available in MCC Web portal and JSS Web portal.

## **Kindly Note:**

- Candidate/Parents/Sponsorer will have to fulfill all eligibility criteria pertaining to the relationship according to the directions / orders of Hon'ble Supreme court of India.
- Active document verification will be done during reporting and admission process.
- All necessary supporting documents relating to relationship with the sponsor has to be submitted and has to be satisfied.
- Candidate/Parents/Sponsorer are directed to adhere to the eligibility criteria before transferring of fee in USD from the sponsors account.
- Foreign Citizen including OCI, PIO, NRI, NRI sponsored by parents, the prescribed tuition fee must be paid in **US Dollars (\$) only from the Sponsor account** and for the same, candidate must produce proof of the transaction made from the sponsor account.
- In respect of the seat allotted under NRI/ NRI Sponsored Category, the ORIGINAL NRI documents must be submitted at the time of reporting and admission to the college. Scanned copy / photocopy of the documents are not accepted and entertained.
